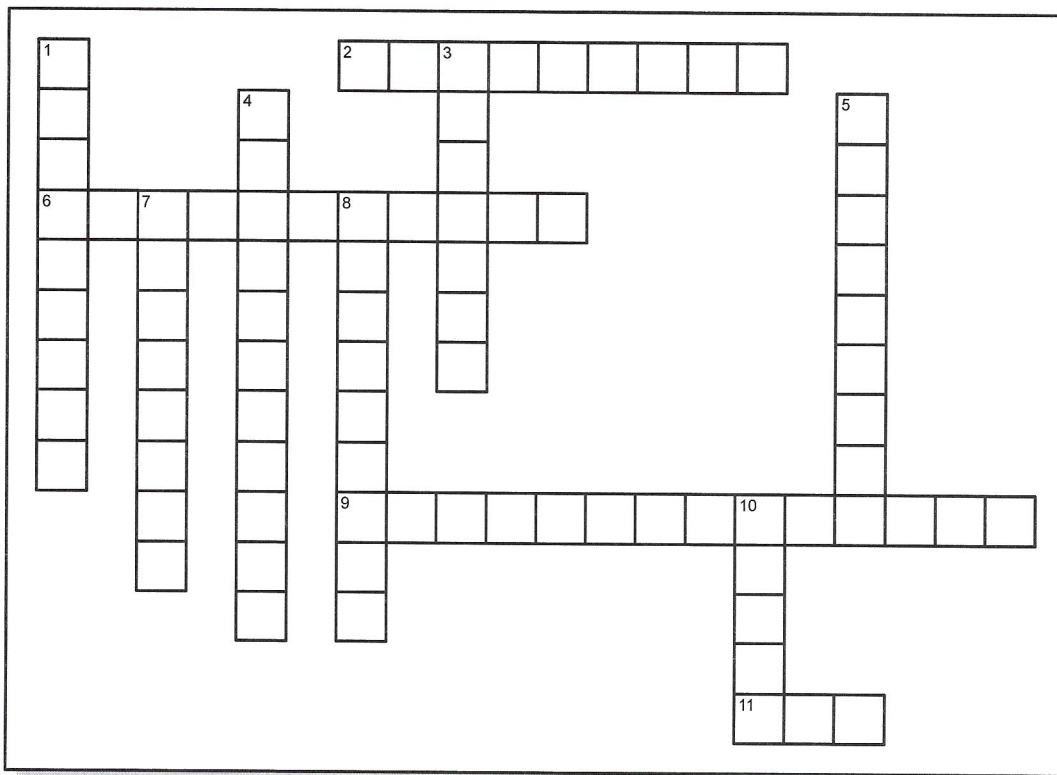

3. council of _____ - a state organization during World War I to coordinate publicity, food and fuel conservation, military preparedness, and campaigns for Liberty Bonds and war savings stamps
4. _____ clause - a clause that, to register to vote, required a person to prove he could read and write parts of the state constitution and was a descendant of persons who were eligible to vote on January 1, 1866; this clause virtually denied blacks the right to vote
5. one who is in disagreement or opposition
7. something that occurs over a wide geographic area; was used to refer to the worldwide influenza epidemic of the late 1910s
8. an interest reserved for each tribal member in the funds collected from mineral leases, sale of lands, etc.
10. compulsory enrollment for military service
