You will use a presentation software tool (such as Microsoft PowerPoint, Google Slides, or OpenOffice Impress) to create your presentation. Your presentation should include basic information about the country from your notes sheet, as well as information on the country's culture, history with the British empire, and other important facts. Your presentation should be between 6-12 slides in length. *Be sure to use at least 5 images in your presentation*.

Some important facts to remember when creating your presentation:

- Use larger fonts (16 pt and higher)
- Use easy-to-read fonts, and avoid cursive and light colors (unless you have a dark background)
- When re-sizing images, drag from the corner so the image isn't stretched vertically or horizontally
- Avoid using too much text on one slide
- Use images to help make your presentation more interesting make sure your images match the text of the slide
- o Some programs have slide templates that make formatting your presentation easier
