


To the Students

You will also learn about government and economics in the focus countries today.

Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport is key to these connections. The airport is the world's busiest with more than 900,000 flights carrying over 100,000,000 passengers and nearly 650,000 tons of cargo each year. Millions of these passengers and tons of cargo are traveling to other countries in the world.

As a citizen of Georgia in the twenty-first century, you will have many opportunities to connect to the larger world. What you learn in this book will help you as you continue your life's journey.




