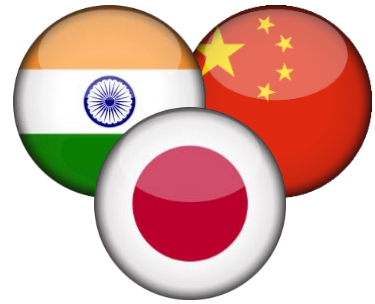


**Chapter 14: India**  
*Internet Activity*

Across the continent of Asia, there are many forms of government with different levels of citizen participation. In this lesson, you will use videos and websites to gather information about the governments of India, China, and Japan. You will use that information to answer questions and play games on Quizlet. Finally, you will create an online comic using *Storyboard That!* about one of the countries' governments.



**Part 1: Background Information**

**Directions:** Navigate to the CIA World Factbook by typing in [cia.gov](http://cia.gov) in your browser. Scroll down to “The World Factbook” and click on the “Visit World Factbook” link. Scroll down to “Explore Countries”. Type in one of the countries’ names from the table below. Scroll down to read the information you need to fill in the notes table.

- 1) Select “Flashcards” and go through each card to find the definition. Note the audio symbol is available to read each term or definition aloud.
- 2) After you have finished with flashcards, try the “Learn” and “Match” activities. Write down your fastest time on the Match activity here: \_\_\_\_\_
- 3) Now, try the “Test” activity. If you get less than 9 correct, try again until you get 9 or 10 terms correct. Write down your score here: \_\_\_\_\_
- 4) If you finish #3 the first time, try the Gravity activity.

Your comic should:

- have 3-6 complete panels with characters and dialogue
- showcase your knowledge of the government with facts
- be creative and make sense to your reader
- use characters and scenes that fit your subject matter

When you are finished, choose Save, then follow your teacher’s directions for logging in. After the save has been completed, copy the url link from your address bar, and write it below.
