

- 1. According to the compass rose, in which direction is the Atlantic Ocean from the Georgia colony?
- 2. Using the scale, approximately how many miles wide is the ceded portion of Georgia at its widest east—west point?
- 3. Which British colonies and territories bordered Georgia in 1773?
- 4. What years are shown on the map for Indian land cessions?
- 5. Based on the map, in what year was the earliest land cession shown in Georgia?
- 6. Which ocean bordered Georgia during this time period?
- 7. Which colony or territory lay directly south of Georgia in 1773?
- 8. According to the map, modern-day state lines are shown. Which present-day state lies directly west of Georgia?
- 9. Compare the land cessions from 1733 to 1773. In sentence form, describe the general direction of the land cessions.
- 10. In which year were the largest cessions?
- 11. Why do you think the colony of Georgia continued to expand westward during this time period?
- 12. Compare the boundaries of the Georgia colony in 1773 with the boundaries of the modern state of Georgia. What are two major differences you notice?
