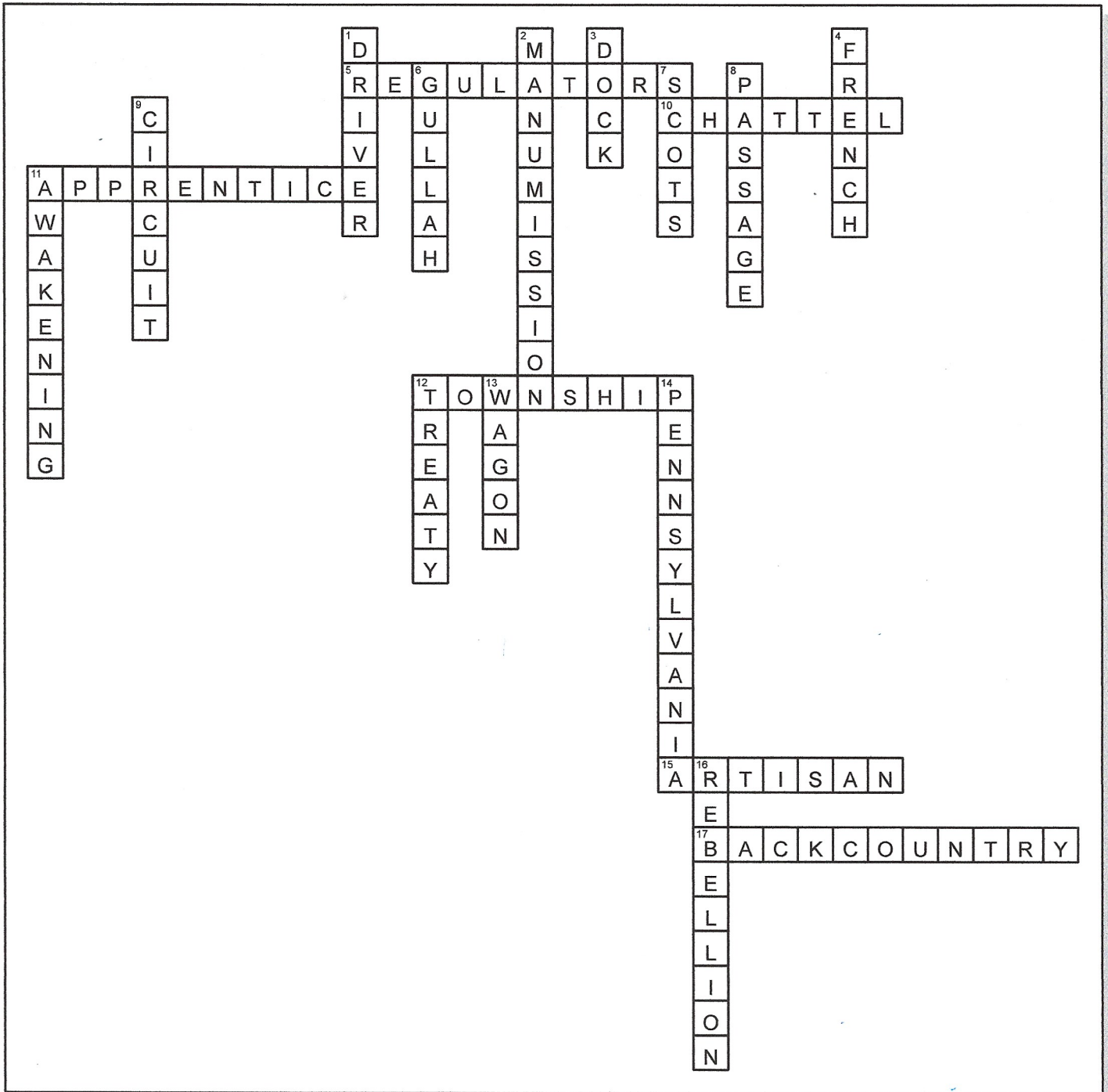


Chapter 6: A Rich and Royal Colony
